Referral is made

The relevant referral form needs to be completed by either the staff member or pupil to help create a picture of need and aid in the planning of the session to maximise potential progress.

SEND team will  
review the  
referrals

The SEND team will review referrals at dept. meeting and assess from the information whether the referral needs a therapy assessment first, if it needs to be overseen by the therapy team, or if it can be planned by the intervention team.

Therapy referral

A therapy referral will be sent to the Wellbeing Coordinator, who will use their professional judgement of which area of therapy (SaLT, Occupational therapy, Psychotherapy, Art therapy, Play therapy) and how to proceed.

Intervention team

If the 1:1 or small group therapy is more academic, social or pastoral, it can be referred to the intervention worker who will plan specific targeted work for 6 sessions before it is reviewed again.
