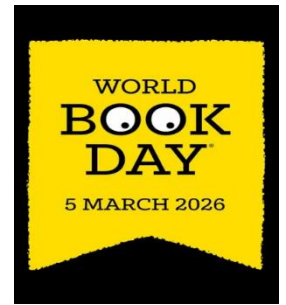

During Class:

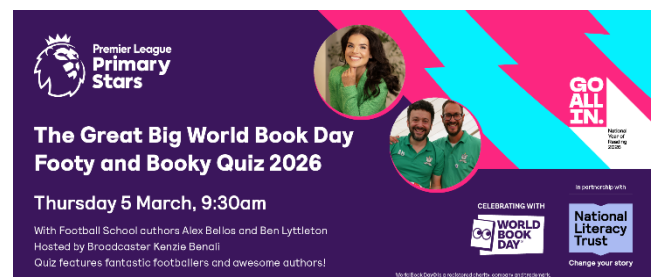
